# 1. How long does the season run?

Sessions start Late October to March - Scheduled Sundays @ 1:30 p.m.

## 2. How many sessions are there?

• There are 14 sessions including a Christmas Family Fun Day and a Wind-Up Party

# 3. How long are the sessions?

- Little Rock and Pre-Novice groups are one hour
- Novice and Junior are 1-1/2 hours

# 4. What are the age ranges?

Ages are 6 to 17.

# 5. What are the ages for the various groups?

- Little Rocks 6-7 Pre-Novice 8-10
- Novice 11-12
- Junior 13+

Ages are just a guideline. There is room to move up or down.

#### 6. How much does it cost?

- Little Rock and Pre-Novice \$140.00
- Novice and Junior \$180.00

### 7. What equipment do I need?

 If you don't have your own, we can supply brushes, sliding devices and sliders each week. Helmets are **mandatory** for the Little Rock group.

# 8. What type of clothing do I require?

• Clean indoor runners are required. Dress in layers. Everyone has different tolerances. Stretchy pants are advised. The arena is about zero degrees.

### 9. Who runs the league?

• The league is run entirely by volunteers. We enlist parents, grandparents and curling enthusiasts to volunteer on each sheet every session.

#### 10. What is taught in the sessions?

We teach the basics of sweeping, sliding, shooting, and sportsmanship.

# 11. Do you play league games?

• Eventually we get into games, however there is no structured league play.

# 12. Do you have smaller rocks for the Little Rock group?

 We do have smaller rocks that are the same circumference as the big rocks but much lighter at 26 pounds versus the 46 pounds of the big rock.

Juniors follow the club philosophy of the Shamrock being a fun place to be. The kids have fun with some instruction instead of all instruction and no fun.
