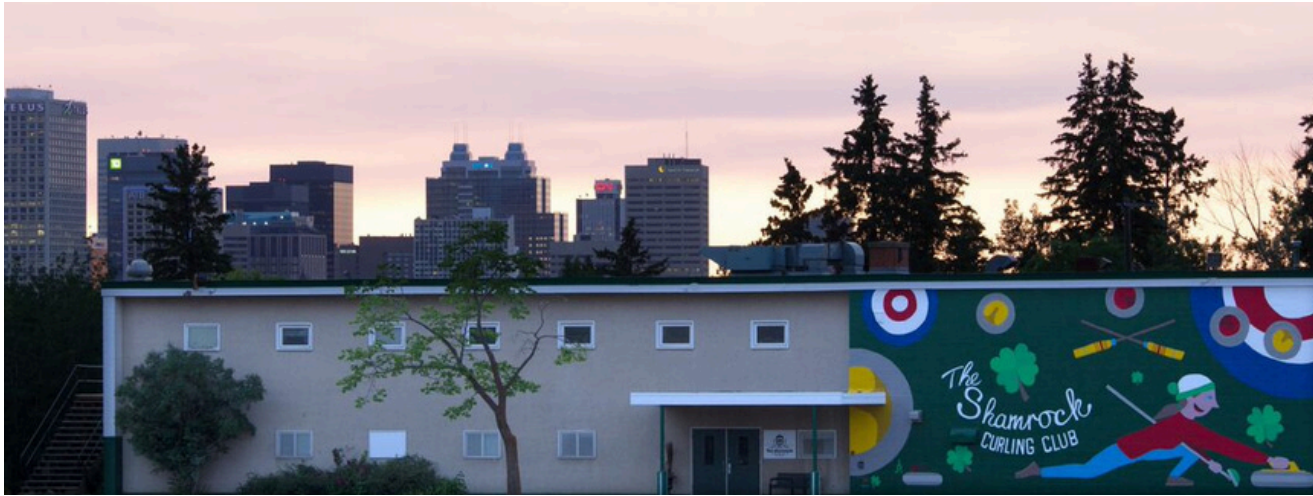

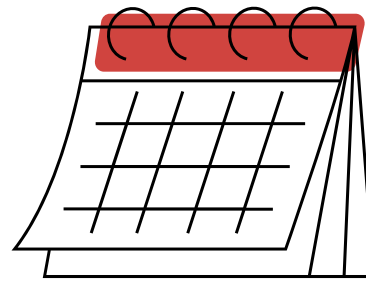
Mug Board
